The aim of the project is to strengthen the capacity of Georgia's public administration, which will include Ivane Javakhishvili in Tbilisi State University Medical Faculty's activities to increase:

the qualifications of administrative and academic staff

exchange of experience and knowledge transfer (including digitalisation)

and develop civil society by promoting the involvement of young doctors in the non-governmental sector



### Project measurable results:

2 visits to Latvia
3 visits to Georgia

Conducted training courses and prepared training materials for 6 courses:

- Digitalisation of laboratory processes;
- Team-building practices for academic staff and medical staff;
- Daily communication in the organisation, crisis communication;
- Integrating digital solutions into the content and process of study courses;
- EU-funded projects opportunities and challenges;
- Training teams for capacity building.

Trained 14 Georgia teachers as lecturers who can provide training after the project has been carried out in Georgia - 5 courses:

- Digitisation of laboratory processes;
- Team-building practices for academic staff and medical staff;
- Daily communication in the organisation, crisis communication;
- Integrating digital solutions into the content and process of study courses;
- EU-funded projects opportunities and challenges

#### Recommendations prepared:

- -on matters relating to the strengthening of administrative capacity.

### **Training Programs**

1 Team Building

Training on team building practices was delivered to 6 staff members.

2 Burnout & Emotional Intelligence

30 participants were trained on burnout and emotional intelligence. A training course was developed for the Georgian partners to implement in their daily training program.

3 EU Project Investment Opportunities

20 participants were trained on EU project investment opportunities.

4 Disinformation & Crisis Communication

24 participants were trained on combating disinformation in healthcare and crisis communication.





## Training Programs (cont.)

- Digitalization of Laboratory Processes

  12 participants were trained on the experience of the PSKUS in digitalizing laboratory processes.
- Residents, Young Doctors & NGOs
  6 participants were trained on the role of residents,
  young doctors, and NGOs in Latvia.

- 2 Health Technology Opportunities
  20 participants were trained on health technology
  opportunities, from idea to market-ready product.
- Digital Health
  12 participants were trained on digital health.

#### **RSU Simulation Center**

Experience exchange visit to the RSU Simulation Center. The Georgian partners were very interested in this visit, as they want to implement a similar center at TVU.

#### LU P. Stradiņš Medical College

Experience exchange visit to LU P. Stradiņš Medical College. The Georgian partners learned about how Latvia trains healthcare support personnel, such as masseurs, cosmetologists, podiatrists, and laboratory assistants.

#### Training Staff


The project also trains staff to deliver relevant lectures.


