

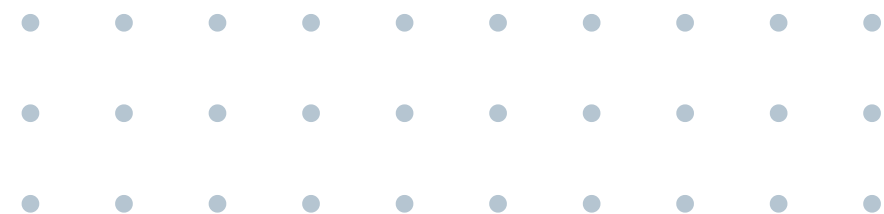

- Timeframe: June 2023 to November 2024.

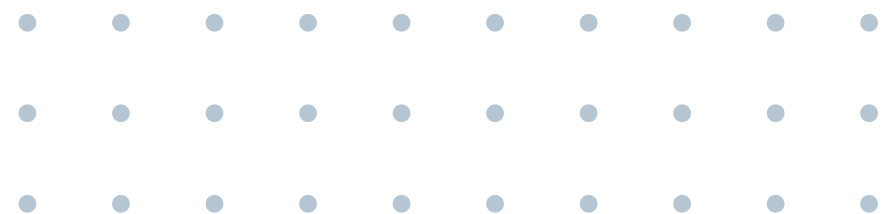


SIMULATION-BASED TRAINING

Establish a Simulation Center at TSU to:

- Integrate VR and advanced simulators for skill-building.
- Create realistic training scenarios (e.g., emergency responses, childbirth).
- Develop specialized instructor programs.

Benefits: Safe, hands-on learning environment for students, residents, and healthcare professionals.





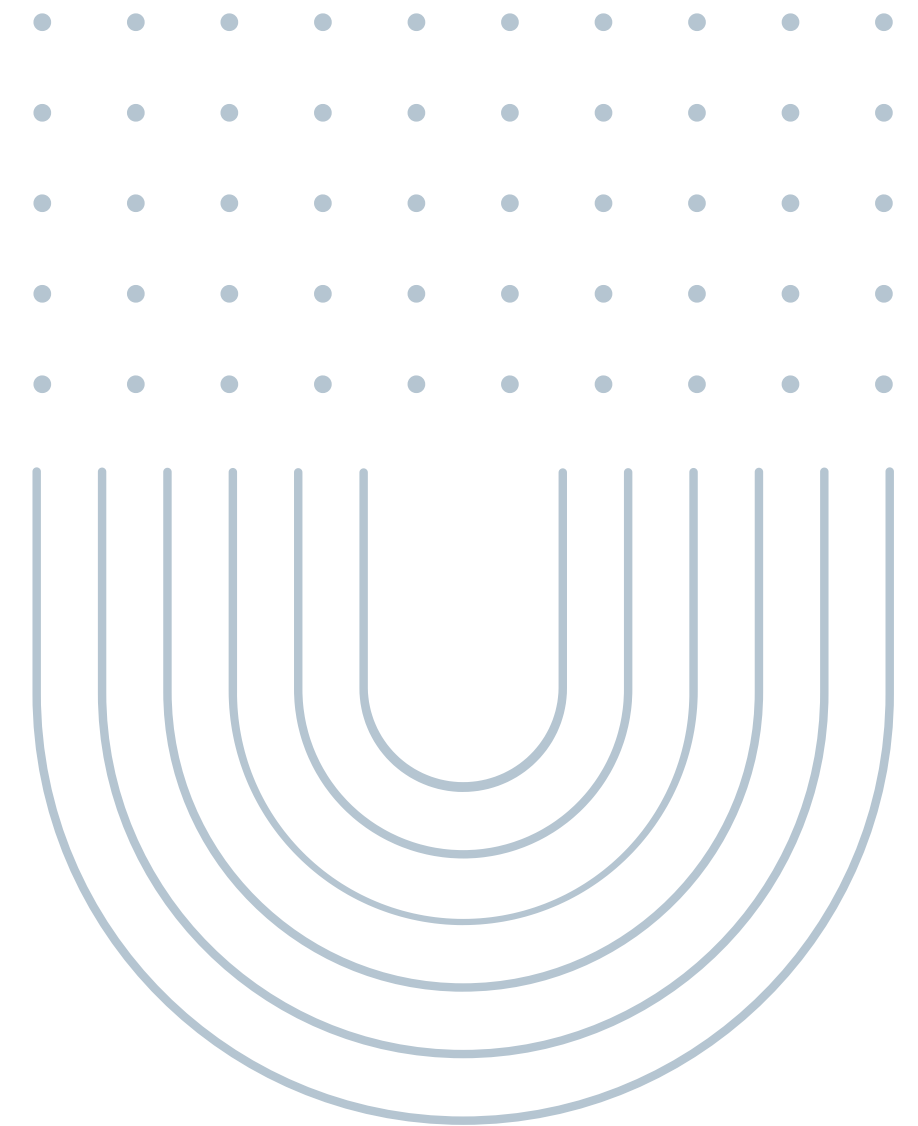
Residency Program Enhancements:

- Align programs with international standards.
- Address shortages in high-risk specialties like emergency medicine.



Continuing Education:

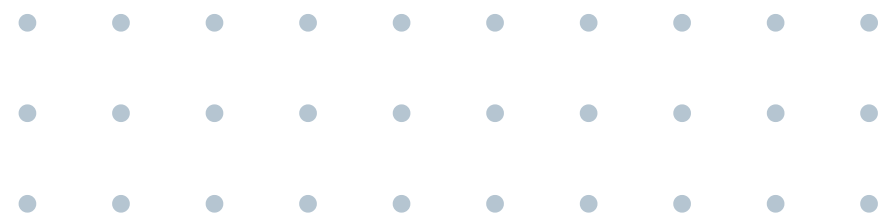
- Shift certification responsibilities to professional associations.
- Incorporate simulation-based content and align with EU standards.

NURSING PROFESSION DEVELOPMENT

- Elevate the prestige of nursing through advocacy and collaboration with healthcare institutions.
- Transition nursing education from vocational to higher education.
- Establish unified certification and regulatory systems for nurses.



REGIONAL AND SYSTEMIC ACCESSIBILITY



- Develop regional training centers to ensure education access outside urban areas.
- Engage with stakeholders to address healthcare system risks affecting professional training.



- Support NGOs in advocating for healthcare education policies.

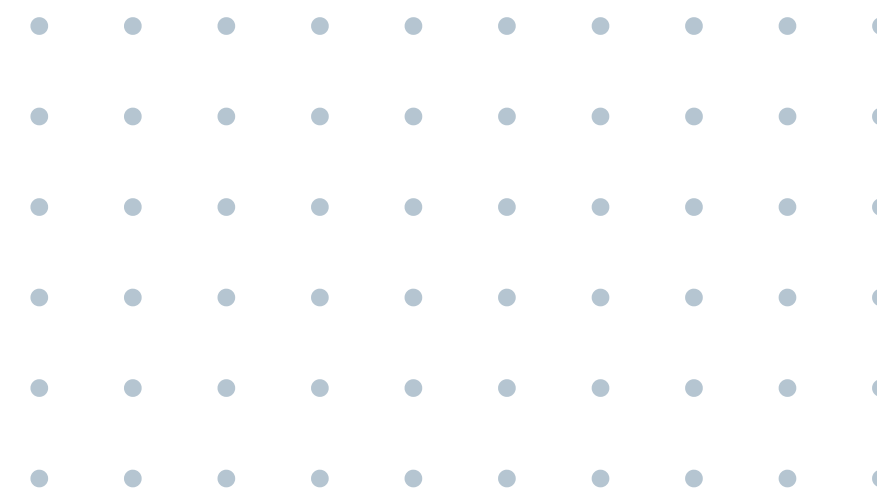


COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS

Strengthen partnerships with private, public, and international organizations for sustainable development.



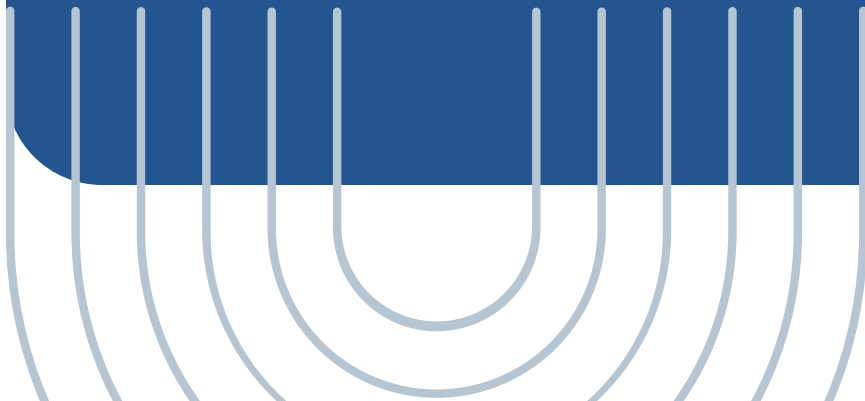
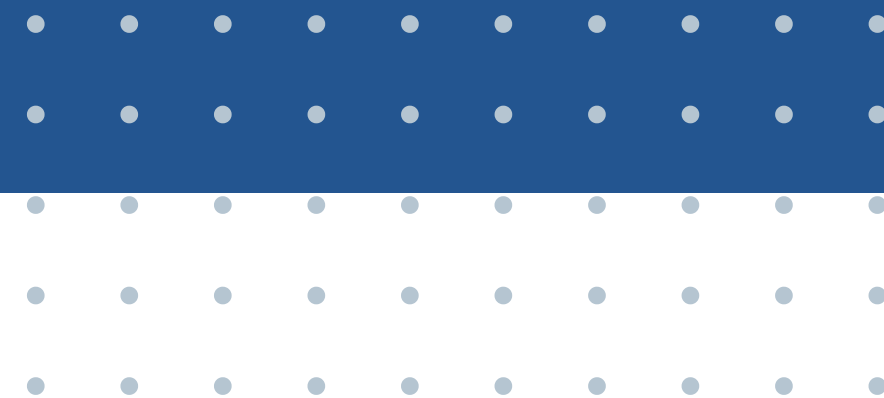
